Grade 12 Summative Evaluation/Exam Schedule:

Due to the constraints of a June graduation, June exams will be written in two stages again this year. Grade 12 Exams will begin two days earlier on **Tuesday, June 18, 2018**. Senior students will have some exams on Tuesday the 18th or Wednesday the 19th while the rest of the school has regular classes (still the review period). All grade 12 students will have completed their exams by **Friday, June 21**. All exams are written in the morning so all students are expected to be in their regular classes in the afternoon during senior exams, unless prior arrangements have been made with any teacher/s involved.

During the regular exam schedule, Thursday June 20-Tuesday June 25:

Students who are not writing an exam should be studying at home unless they have made specific arrangements to receive help from a teacher. These arrangements need to be made in advance as most teachers are supervising an exam or have other supervision duties during the examination period. Students who need extra help before their exams should see their teachers during the review days for permission to attend afternoon sessions and should sign up in the main office. All exams will be written in the morning in the cafeteria and students should sign up for the early bus unless prior arrangements have been made with a teacher. Other culminating activities and oral exams/interviews will be scheduled by the teacher.

Absences:

- <u>Students Under Eighteen Years of Age:</u> If you are ill on the day of an exam, your parent or guardian must contact Mrs. Stevens @ 613-279-2131 before 8:30 a.m. to arrange an alternate time for you to write the exam.
- <u>Students Eighteen Years of Age or Older:</u> You must contact Mrs. Stevens before 8:30 a.m. if you are ill on the day of an exam to arrange an alternate time for you to write an exam.

Grade 12 Exams Tuesday June 18 and Wednesday June 19

Students will be expected to return to their regular classes once they have completed their morning exams.

Exam Procedure:

Students must arrive at the examination room by 8:25 a.m. All exams start at 8:30 am. Students are expected to be on time and to bring all necessary materials to each examination (including textbooks to be returned to teachers). Cell Phones are not allowed in Examination Rooms.
